

knob-and-escutcheon


set by P. & F. Corbin appeared in the company's 1874-75 catalog, and also was produced in extremely rare cast enamel.

NOTE: TYPICAL BASE BOARD, CHAIR RAIL, DOOR PANEL, DOOR AND WINDOW MOLDING, AND MUNTIN AND MULLION MOLDING ARE ALL FLAT. ALL (EXCEPT FOR MUNTIN AND MULLION) HAVE A 1/4" ROUND OVER EDGE. -ALL SURFACES APPEAR AS AGED SPRUCE WOOD.


SAND BLASTING SURFACES TO BRING OUT TEXTURE IS RECOMMENDED.









DETAIL OF MACRAME VALANCE
